

BROOKLAWN S.A. CANNED FOOD DRIVE

Rules & Collection Procedures – 2011

*This year's Canned Food Drive will begin on **Monday January 31** and continue until **Friday February 11**. Members of the Student Council Community Service Committee will distribute all food items collected, to help needy families in our area...*

- 1. Each homeroom will be given a cardboard box to collect cans and other non-perishable food items as they come in:**
 - NO HOME-PACKAGED ITEMS of any kind will be accepted. Only commercially canned or boxed food that will not spoil may be donated.
 - NO PET FOOD or any other item unfit for human consumption may be donated.
 - NO EXPIRED FOOD ITEM with a date that already passed may be donated.
 - Ramen noodle packages, extremely small cans/boxes, or similar items will count as one "can" for every TEN items donated.
 - We reserve the right to reject any item for donation.

- 2. Each Student Council homeroom representative is responsible to:**
 - Motivate the students of their homeroom to bring in as many food items as possible to help needy families in our community.
 - To keep an accurate count of how many cans and other food items have been placed into their homeroom collection box.
 - To bring this box directly to B-16 with a "can count" attached whenever it fills up, and on all designated "collection days" (see below).

- 3. There will be "Collection Days" on FRI. FEB. 4, and FRI. FEB. 11:**
 - During homeroom on these days, all boxes (whether full or not) should be brought by a student to Room B-16 with the Can Count Form filled out and attached.
 - We will empty the homeroom box while you wait. Can counts will be tabulated and reported in the afternoon announcements.

- 4. Spirit Points are given for the number of cans donated in each collection period:**
 - The two collection periods will be defined as January 31-February 4, and February 7-11.
 - The can counts for each collection period will NOT be cumulative. We will award 5 Spirit Points to the grade that brings in the most cans during each collection period.

- 5. The homeroom with the most cans per student in each grade wins a pizza party:**
 - This party will include soda and pizza paid for by Brooklawn S.A., and will be held at a date and time agreed to by Mr. Miller and the homeroom teacher.
