Come to school dressed neatly and comfortably. You must exercise good judgment when selecting what to wear every day.

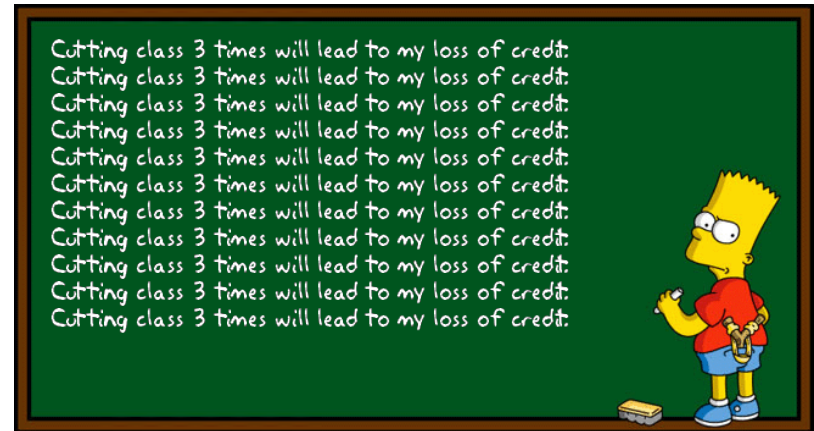
Dress not appropriate includes:

- * 3rd time = Loss of Credit = No graduation or summer school!



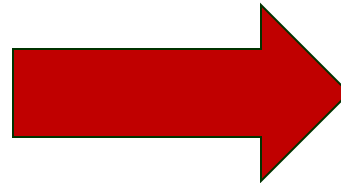
The Attendance Policy

- * Parents must call 973-682-2815 to report the absence to the office
- * For year long & semester courses
 - 5 absences – parents are notified by letter
 - 10th absence – parents notified by administrator
 - 15th absence – attendance contract is made with student
 - 21st absence – loss of credit for that class

Tardy to school

- 5th time = warning
- 10th time = Saturday detention
- 15th time = parent contact & Saturday detention
- 20th time = parent contact & ISS

Tardy to class

- 1st time = Teacher discipline
- 2nd time = 1 teacher detention
- 3rd & 4th time = 2 office detentions
- 5th time = Saturday detention & parent contact

Activities/Athletics Contracts

- * Students must be present a minimum of 4 hours of instructional time (not including lunch) to participate in any activity or athletic event that day. This includes practice.
