RE: STATE TESTING

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The High School Proficiency Assessment will be administered on March 2, 3, and 4, 2010 beginning at 7:40 AM each morning.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE FOR MARCH 2, 3, AND 4

GRADE 11 STUDENTS – should report to their bus stops at normal time to be at school prior to testing.

GRADES 9, 10 AND 12 STUDENTS - should be at their bus stops in the usual location two and a half hours after the normal time (for example a 7:00 bus stop at a specific location will become a 9:30 bus stop at the same location, etc.) Students who walk to school should arrive by 10:00 AM.

On March 5, all students should report to their bus stops at their usual time. School will be in regular session on Friday, March 5, 2010 for all students.

The High School Proficiency Assessment is a high stakes examination on which we want our students to excel. Please be advised that the state has ruled that there be NO UNAUTHORIZED ELECTRONIC DEVICES, MP3 PLAYERS, I-PODS, CELL PHONES OR COATS IN THE TEST ROOMS. Students who violate this rule will have their tests voided and will have to retake the HSPA in October of their senior year.

There will be no morning classes at Morris County School of Technology on March 2, 3, and 4 for all juniors.
