



Full Day SKIP Frequently Asked Questions

At what phone number can you be reached?

The number for Full Day SKIP is (973) 255 - 0445

Are food services available?

Lunch and snacks are NOT provided. Please send your child to Full Day SKIP with 2 snacks, a lunch, and drinks. Additionally, please send your child to SKIP with any utensils that they may need.

Will there be a nurse on duty? Will my child be able to take their medications?

Yes and yes. A nurse will be on duty and available to dispense medications, so long as doctor's orders are provided.

Where do I drop off my child?

The Full Day SKIP program is housed at Central Middle School, located at 1620 Route 46 West, Parsippany, NJ. Please enter the building via the main entrance on the Route 46 side of the school.

At what time does the Full Day Program begin?

The Full Day SKIP program begins at 7:15 am.

I need to pick up my child early, is that allowed?

Absolutely. Parents and guardians may pick up (or drop off) at anytime between 7:15 am and 6:00 pm.

What are the drop off / pick up procedures?

All students must be dropped off and signed in by an adult. Please enter Central Middle School via the Route 46 entrance and see the receptionist at the front desk. Pick up is similar: upon arrival at CMS adults will be asked to show photo ID and then will be prompted to sign their child out.

What does the daily schedule look like?

Informal welcoming activities will be held between 7:15 and 9:00 am. The children will then be provided time to eat their morning snack. Following snack, the children's day is organized into a six period bell schedule. Each period will last for about 45 minutes. Lunch will be held from 12:30-1:30pm. End of the day activities include afternoon snack and play / movie time.

Over the course of the six period day, children will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational, enriching, and fun activities. Classes include Arts and Crafts, Sports, and Games. Generally speaking, there is very little "down time." Our day is crafted in a manner so as to keep the children active and having fun.

What should my child take with them for the day?

All children should be dressed as they would for any day of school. We recommend that the children are comfortable and wear layers. We will go outside to play if the weather is nice, so please plan accordingly.

We do not encourage parents / guardians to send their children in with toys, electronics, money, or other valuables. The SKIP program is not responsible for lost or damaged items.
