We are also proceeding with our virtual ceremonies and these will be posted to the appropriate school's webpage.

We will be able to provide meals for ***any student in need*** until June 30. The last day of distribution will be ***Monday, June 29 (for two days of meals)*** between 11:00 a.m. and noon. Thank you to our middle school Security Guards, Mr. Kevin Duffy (CMS) and Mr. Joseph Selitto (BMS), for their helpful presence on distribution days.
